

Milestone 3 - Part 2

Setup Your Domain Name - Process Map

This process map details how to setup your domain name and point it to ClickFunnels. Please read the entire document and watch the tutorial video before proceeding.

Step 1. Buy Your Domain Name

Step 1A: Buy your domain name from www.CloudFlare.com if you haven't already done so. Then continue to Step 2, below.

If you've already bought your domain name elsewhere, you'll need to add it to CloudFlare before continuing to the next step. To do that, follow these instructions.

Step 1B. Sign up for the FREE plan at www.CloudFlare.com

Step 1C. Go to the dashboard and click "Add a Site" and enter your domain name without the "www". ie: Just enter "yoursite.com"

Step 1D. Once you're finished adding your domain name, CloudFlare will give you what is called a "Nameserver".

Step 1E. CloudFlare will give you two (2x) Nameservers. Copy them down and save them somewhere. Then go to wherever you registered your domain name (ie: GoDaddy) and replace the default name servers with the new ones CloudFlare gave you.

If you're not sure how to do this, the easiest way is to reach out to tech support at your domain registrar and send them this message:

"Hi there, I recently added my site to CloudFlare. Can you please update my domain name _____ so that the DNS records point to these name servers: _____, _____".

It's also very likely that your domain registrar has documentation on how to update your Nameservers if you'd like to try doing it yourself. Here are the instructions on how to do this with various popular domain registrars:

Note: Are you using a different domain registrar? Simply search in Google “*Update Nameservers _____*” and fill in the blank with whatever domain name registrar you’re using.

Step 1F Once your nameservers have been added to your domain registrar, go back to CloudFlare to verify that they’ve been setup.

Step 2. Point Cloudflare Domain Name To ClickFunnels

Once your domain name is registered inside CloudFlare, we need to point it to ClickFunnels.

Step 3. Add Your Domain Name To ClickFunnels

Log into your Clickfunnels account and go to your “Account Settings” page. Scroll down to “Domains” and click “Add New Domain” and select “Add Your Own Domain”. Remove the “www” from the box and enter your domain name. Then check the box that says “This domain is registered on Cloudflare.”

Step 4. Associate Your Domain Name With Your Funnel

After your domain name has been added, you'll be prompted to choose which funnel to associate it with. Select your funnel from the drop down box & choose "Associate Funnel"

Step 5. Add SSL & Choose Home Page

In this final step we're going to choose our home page and setup SSL. To do that go to "Settings", scroll down to "Domains" and click on the domain you've just added. Under "Default Page" choose your "Funnel Name / Home Page". Then click "Save". Do the same thing for "404 / Error Page"

Next, scroll down the page & click "Expand" beside "SSL" and click "Add SSL"

Once that is complete, you're OK to move on to the next step in the milestone.
